Our Dining Room remains closed following dinner on March 13, 2020. Menus have been provided for Saturday through Wednesday. Moving forward, menus will be delivered to your home by our mail department. Please return menus to the Dining Room. **Dinner** will continue to be sent to your residence.

Breakfast and lunch are only available for residents who are on the breakfast or lunch meal plan. If you are in critical need of food supplies and have not been able to obtain groceries, please call Leya or Jrhon at 610-359-4433.
