RE: **CONTINUED UPDATE: COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR DUNWOODY VILLAGE**

Please know that we do **not** have any cases of COVID-19 on our campus. Our goal is to maintain that status!

Some residents have expressed the desire to leave campus and stay with their families. We have been advised that residents are safer if remaining on campus due to the possibility that family members might have been exposed to the virus. If you are leaving to stay with family or to travel to other areas at this time, you will not be permitted to return to the campus until the quarantine and no visitor restrictions are lifted. Those who traveled previous to the COVID-19 quarantines remain in their unit without campus contact for 14 days.

If you need to leave campus for a medical appointment, to go to the pharmacy or grocery store, we will not ban you from campus. All Dunwoody activities and shopping trips are suspended. Starting tomorrow, March 18, 2020, this includes bus trips to the grocery stores.

Alternatives to grocery shopping:

We suggest that you use Peapod: www.peapod.com or Instacart: www.instacart.com for ordering groceries. Items being delivered are ONLY to be delivered to the front desk, not to your home. If you are unable to pick up items at the front desk, we will assist with delivery to your home. You will need to create an online account and use your credit card for payment. The resale shop and gift shop are closed. However, the gift shop will be able to accept orders and deliver for products they have in stock. Tomorrow, March 18, 2020, we will deliver menus for next week. If you are a couple, fill out your individual name on opposite sides of the menu so that dining services knows your residence requires two meals. If using options, attach the option to the menu and give both to the mailman or leave at the front desk if you need to stretch your legs.
