RE: CONTINUED UPDATE: COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR DUNWOODY VILLAGE

We appreciate our residents' continued cooperation and support in helping us provide for the health and safety of our campus and community!

All recent Protocols remain in effect. Should you want to review them, they are posted on our website at <a href="https://www.dunwoody.org">www.dunwoody.org</a>. Notifications are dated and posted on the home-page, left side of screen.

No outside cleaning services or independent vendors should be permitted to enter your home. Because your residence is part of the Dunwoody facility, this is a violation of current policy in effect and may place your fellow residents, the Dunwoody campus and our community at risk.

Visitors remain prohibited from all areas of Dunwoody at this time. **Hospice visitation** (evaluated on a case-by-case basis) may be permitted under special circumstances. This must be approved in advance by Brandon Jolly, Director of Health Services, or Wendy Hix, Director of Nursing. You will be informed of and required to follow specified precautions if visitation is permitted.

If you receive a **2020 Census letter**, please fill it out on-line. Previous arrangements for the census workers to interview residents one-on-one here on campus have been canceled.

Included is a notice from Erin Price, PC/IL Social Service Supervisor instructing residents that they may **register to vote through absentee ballot**. The application is attached; additional applications may be picked up from Kim Ring, Resident Engagement Coordinator in our Marketing Department.

Channel 1970 is putting together a full roster of in-house programming! We plan to include: documentaries, movies, religious services, and, possibly, exercise class to do at home. Of course, we will broadcast the Berlin Philharmonic. We hope to roll this out by early next week. Courses and interviews with selected staff and residents are being considered. Dr. Stuckert plans to attempt a truncated Residents Association Meeting in April at its regular time on-line.

Menus will continue to be delivered to your residence as per previous notices. Peapod and Instacart are suggested for grocery orders for delivery to the front desk.
