CONTINUED UPDATE: COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR DUNWOODY VILLAGE

As of today, we have not had any further cases of COVID-19, so we hope that we were able to contain it to the one area. The residents that are quarantined are doing well and we are monitoring them daily. The staff that were exposed are also quarantined and being checked daily.

We are seeing a lot less people in the common areas! Thank you very much for staying in your apartment – for those still roaming around – Please try to stay home! I know that it is hard – but it is what we need to do! Keep up the good work!

#### **SOME OTHER UPDATES:**

Some confusion on what the Marketplace is. That is where you can call and get groceries delivered to your door from Dining services. The list of items was sent out yesterday.

#### Fire Alarms:

Those who are <u>not</u> quarantined to their homes should go to their respective assembly points but stay a minimum of 6 feet apart. Those who are quarantined to their homes should open their doors but <u>NOT</u> enter the hallway. When the alarm stops sounding or when security comes and says it is OK to return, residents may return to their apartments. The light system is still **not** operational. The fire drill has been postponed therefore no alarm is a test alarm. Any alarm should be taken seriously.

#### **EVS Changes:**

Starting Monday, March 30, 2020 the Environmental Services team will be going to every other week housecleaning. On the other week, they will be performing a through cleaning of all common areas. If you need cleaning service weekly or sheets/towels, please contact Gary Ladeau or Ken Matsinger to coordinate. This change will be for the foreseeable future. It is very important that we keep our environment clean!
