DV Employees -	7 cases – self-isolated at home
DAH Employees-	2 cases – self-isolated at home
COVID related deaths	as of 4/25/20 – 4 deaths

**Information for Care Center Residents and Families**

Correction – the other day I mentioned that if you wanted a coloring packet or puzzle packet and you live in the care center, you need to call the Activities department – but I had the wrong phone number. Please call **610-723-4766** and leave a message with your name, room number, and which packet you would like and they will get one to you.

**Information for Independent Residents** Please report any symptoms of fever with sore throat, congestion, and cough to Health & Wellness.

It seems blatantly obvious that you should immediately notify Health and Wellness if you are being tested for COVID-19. We have certain important protocols for how to handle “persons under investigation” (PUI) and COVID-19 positive cases. If we do not know, then we are unable to protect our staff and our residents properly. It does not matter if you see a Dunwoody doctor or a doctor off site. As you will note above, the reason for this reminder is that we were just notified of a situation in which a resident had been tested 4 days earlier neglected to inform us of this and ventured off campus numerous times (some of those times without a face mask) and placed others at unnecessary risk. *Please stay on campus! Please communicate responsibly with us. Please help us to protect one another.*

Residents who placed themselves on the ACME list must wait until they are called before they can place an order. If you need items prior to your turn on the list you can place an order through Luigi and Giovanni's or through the Dunwoody Marketplace. If you have items on your ACME list that you can get through the Dunwoody Marketplace, please try to get them from Dunwoody. Once you are called and your order is completed you will need to call Erin Price at 610-707-4898 again to get back on the list if you need more items, if you do not place yourself back on the list you will NOT be called again to place an order. If you placed an order for ACME and did not receive an item on your list this means that the item was not in stock at the store and there will NOT be another delivery for any missing items, you must call back and put your name on the list again if you want to try to get the items at another time. So far, we have completed 107 ACME orders, that's over 1,000 items that were delivered to our residents!
