Since Governor Wolf has lifted restrictions on construction companies throughout the Commonwealth Dunwoody Village will have some construction beginning May 11, 2020. These new residents have sold their homes and need us to provide their new homes for them. May 18, 2020 we will resume construction on the East Country House hallway project.
