Residential living –	1 case on Campus – Retested to be cleared 1 case on Campus – under quarantine at home
Skilled Nursing -	0 cases
Personal Care -	0 cases
DV Employees -	<b>6 cases – self-isolated at home</b>
DAH Employees-	<b>1 case – self-isolated at home</b>
COVID related deaths	as of 4/29/20 – 5 deaths

So, some good news – we have had 3 staff members recovered and returned to work 4/28/20 – 2 were from Dunwoody at Home and 1 was from Dunwoody Village – Nursing department. We sadly had a new Dunwoody at Home employee test positive 4/28/20. Our count is now 7 employees and 2 residents.
