Last week we lost a resident that had a COVID-19 test, but results were not back at the time of the resident's death. We received the test results Sunday that the resident was positive, so I have included in the COVID related death total today. We also had a resident in the Care center test positive. We currently have 2 positive cases in the care center and one positive in Residential.

Information for Independent Residents Please report any symptoms of fever with sore throat, congestion, and cough to Health & Wellness. If you do not use a Dunwoody doctor, please let us know **immediately** if you are being tested or have tested positive.
