There are many changes today. We have new guidelines on what to report to families, so I have changed the format to fit the requirements. Each area has their own statistics.

The last few cases we had in the care center were all on the same unit, so Dr. Lawrence and the medical team decided to test the whole unit. Of the 10 residents tested, 5 were positive, 3 are negative and 2 are still pending. We had a death yesterday that was pending and came back inconclusive. I added a separate category until it is determined and they are not in the count for Covid related deaths. I also added recoveries and pending for employees.
