General Update

<u>Staff Testing:</u> There was some confusion over the last few days on the numbers – I have verified then with the care center and these are accurate.

6/23/20 - 82 tested, 79 negative, 3 asymptomatic Positives, the employees that tested positive work in dining, nursing, and transportation and recovered at home. This round is complete. All staff has returned to work.

6/30/20 - 89 tested - 87 negatives, 2 Pending

7/07/20 - 53 tested - 26 negative - 27 pending

7/14/20 - 74 tested

60 Personal Care Residents tested

She will deliver all of the independent Residents and will leave the care center papers at the desk for a staff member to deliver. She will check in like all employees do and will wear a mask and gloves. This change will happen in the next few days. Gift Shop

The gift shop is now open from 11am-2pm Monday – Friday. Up to 3 residents at a time and properly fitted masks are required.

Travel Restrictions:

Due to the rise of Covid-19 cases in certain states, if you travel to the following states, you will need to quarantine for 14 days upon return:

Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nevada, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Utah

Quarantined residents may walk alone with a mask on and must avoid trash rooms. No activities with anyone else are permitted during quarantine.
