Staff Testing:

6/23/20 - 82 tested, 79 negative, 3 asymptomatic Positives, the employees that tested positive work in dining, nursing, and transportation and recovered at home. This round is complete. All staff has returned to work.

Residential Updates:

<u>Walking at Night</u> - Security has asked me to mention to the residents that if you like to walk in the evenings, please wear bright or reflective clothing. It can be hard to see people!
