### **General Update**

### **Staff Testing:**

6/23/20 - 82 tested, 79 negative, 3 asymptomatic Positives, the employees that tested positive work in dining, nursing, and transportation and recovered at home. This round is complete. All staff has returned to work.

6/30/20 - 89 tested - 89 negatives

7/07/20 – 53 tested – 53 negatives

7/14/20 - 73 tested - 70 negative and 3 pending

7/18/20 - 23 tested - 23 negatives

7/21/20 - 29 tested – this is the last group of care center employees

## **Care Center Update:**

7/9/20 - 61 Personal Care Residents tested –61 Negative

The plan for reopening the skilled and Personal Care areas is in its final stages, being reviewed by our medical director and upper management. Our goal is to have it posted on our website on 7/27/20. All care employees and care center residents have been tested so we will begin step one on that day. We have not had a COVID case on campus since June 22, 2020.
