## **Care Center Update:**

There are no concerns in the Care Center at this time. Brandon Jolly continues to work on a plan for re-opening the Care Center.

## **Residential Updates:**

Please remember to follow the guidelines delivered last week and posted on our website: <a href="https://www.dunwoody.org">www.dunwoody.org</a>. We will update the guidelines as we move forward.

Recycling: All materials that contain Dunwoody meals can be recycled if they are clean. The containers cannot contain food and should be washed. If containers or cans are not clean, the entire batch of recycling may be rejected. Cleaned cans, bottles, and dinner containers should be placed in the large cans marked for recycling. If the items are dirty, keep them with your bagged trash and place the bag in the trash cans. Light cardboard such as cereal boxes may be placed with the cardboard or with the paper. Heavy cardboard boxes may be placed on the floor beside the can marked for cardboard and staff collecting the trash will break them down. We are checking with the company that supplies the Dunwoody food bags to determine if they are recyclable and will provide an update as soon as we have an answer.

Residents have asked about using the hot tub. Yes, you may use the hot tub, but use is restricted to the times available for pool use. The pool area remains limited to two persons per time slot. Call the Fitness Center 610-359-4490 to schedule time in the Fitness Center or Pool.

If using the game room, please wipe down the equipment when you are finished. The wipes are located in the back of the room and are placed between the pool stick racks.
