Visitation

Skilled Nursing and Personal Care

Scheduled indoor visitation will be available beginning Monday, May 3rd. Scheduled outdoor visitation will continue to be available as well. We will be transitioning to an electronic sign-up method called Sign Up Genius. There will be a link to connect you to the sign-up specifically for Skilled Nursing and a link specifically for Personal Care on our website on Monday May 3rd. To schedule a visit specifically for May 3rd, please contact 610-359-4503 on Friday 4/30/2021. If you already have upcoming visits scheduled, we will be honoring your date/time. During inclement weather we will move outdoor visits to our safe visiting areas. You will be notified upon arrival about any changes in visit location due to inclement weather. All visitors will continue to complete the COVID-19 screening.

Independent Living

Please note, we are now welcoming overnight guests and guests under age 18. The Guest Apartments are not yet available, but guests may stay in your apartment. We ask that children be supervised at all times by an adult. All guests are asked to keep their masks on in common spaces at Dunwoody and to continue to complete the screening at the main entrance.

Dinner Pick Up

Dinner pick up started last night, Wednesday, April 28. Residents may opt to pick up their dinner from the auditorium. This provides a great opportunity not only to select your meal, but also socialize with your neighbors and see friends you haven't seen in a while, possibly even a year! Pick up will be available Monday to Saturday 5:30pm to 6:30pm. Please bring your reusable bag when you pick up dinner. If you did not receive one, dining will provide it to you.

<u>The Bar</u>

CDC and Regulatory Guidance

Our team is working to incorporate the recent changes with CDC guidance and CMS regulations. We will have an update next week related to changes on our campus.

Construction Update

This week the steel erector will wrap up the structural steel install on the east side of the addition. Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing trades will work on underground rough ins on the east half of the addition, as well as continue underground rough ins in the existing building. The concrete contractor will begin to prep the slab on deck to pour, and possibly pour the floor slab late this week for the second floor. The new set of stairs will be getting installed in stair tower 4 (closest to the pond), and the demo contractor is working on demolishing the old set of stairs that used to be between the kitchen and dining room.

The mason will complete stair tower 3 on the western side of the project in the next day or so, and by mid-week the steel erector will begin to set steel, tying into the steel that has already been set, and working towards the west. The foundations for the new connector corridor should be finished this week, and possibly backfilled also.

Election is May 18th:

The primary election is May 18, 2021. The last day to register to vote is May 3, 2021. The last day to apply for a mail-in or absentee ballot is May 11, 2021. If you voted by mail-in ballot in the general election and requested an annual mail-in ballot you <u>may</u> automatically receive a mail-in ballot. If you are using a mail-in ballot, the ballot must be received by the Bureau of Elections no later than May 18, 2021. A mail-in ballot post-marked May 18, 2021, but received after that date will not be accepted.
