Dear Dunwoody Residents residing in Independent Living,

The Leadership Team is pleased to share that residents residing in the Village, the Country Houses and Penrose may welcome family and friends to visit them *in their homes* **beginning Wednesday April 14th**. Now that residents have been vaccinated, we believe that visits can be done safely, following our guidelines below.

Upon arrival visitors will proceed to the Main Entrance to have their temperatures taken and complete a screening questionnaire. Individuals with a temperature of 100.0 or above or who answer “yes” to any of the questions on the questionnaire will not be permitted to enter. After signing in, visitors will be directed to drive or walk to their destination. Please note it is important for all visitors to check in at the Main Entrance and complete the required screening; this is critical information in the event we would need to complete contact tracing. Additionally, all visitors must wear face masks while on the Dunwoody campus. You and your visitors may walk outside with face masks and proper social distancing from other residents and guests. Please be reminded that there is no indoor visitation in common areas; all visits should take place in your home. We are requesting that you host only 2 adult visitors at a time.

With your support and feedback, we will evaluate this visitation process, continue to review guidelines and make changes as necessary. Our intention is to keep moving forward! If any cases of COVID-19 occur or the positivity rate continues to increase in Delaware County, the visitation policy may change.

Enjoy visiting with your family and friends but keep in mind there is a rising number of cases in Delaware County with the current positivity rate at 8.1% (which is high), there are new strains of COVID surfacing, the vaccine is believed to be about 70% effective in older adults and your guests may not be vaccinated. We want you and your guests to stay healthy!

We appreciate your support and cooperation as we work to slowly and safely reopen our community.
