

Dear Dunwoody Village Residents and Staff,

Late Friday afternoon, we learned of 3 additional new cases of COVID 19 in 2 fully vaccinated staff members and 1 fully vaccinated resident. We are continuing to contact trace and test, and we will keep you fully informed as we have more information. Thankfully at this time, everyone who tested positive is feeling well. We are appreciative of all of our staff who are modifying our protocols as we respond to this news. And we are appreciative of the residents' patience and understanding as we work through this challenge. We continue to follow all regulatory guidance and recommendations in addition to our infection control policies. By regulation, because healthcare staff tested positive, this is considered an outbreak in Skilled Nursing and Personal Care. Residents and staff from these areas will begin testing on Saturday May 22, 2021. In addition, anyone identified through contact tracing will also be tested.

Visitation

We are suspending visitation in Skilled Nursing and Personal Care until we can complete testing of our residents and staff. Visitors may come to Independent Living but must be masked in common areas and we ask that visits be held in resident's homes, not in common spaces.

Dining and Activities

Meals will be delivered to all residents in Skilled Nursing and Personal Care until we can complete testing of our residents and staff.

Meals will be delivered to residents in Independent Living or may be picked up in the Auditorium until we can complete contact tracing and testing of residents in close contact with those who were positive. Dining in The Terrace is temporarily suspended and we will work to re-open soon. Residents in Independent Living may continue with activities, but if you are indoors, in common areas, we are asking that you wear a mask until contact tracing and testing is complete for Independent Living residents.

Although I am not on campus, please know I have been in constant communication with our leadership team and our staff. Technology like Zoom is very helpful at keeping us connected at time like this. Again, thank you to the residents for your partnership and understanding, and thank you to our amazing leadership and staff. Together we are "Dunwoody Strong"!
