The last week or so has presented us with storms, heat and high humidity. Welcome to July! Stay cool, layer clothing and hydrate! This time of year finds things slowing down, and so it is with the many rapid changes that occurred on our Dunwoody Campus over the last few months. For many weeks things were changing fast and furious and our updates were full with this information. We have transitioned back to welcoming visitors, in-person dining, in-person activities and programs, and our lives are more closely aligned with the "pre-COVID normal". That being said, we are hearing more and more about the increase in COVID cases across the country, specifically related to the Delta variant. This seems to be more prevalent in areas where vaccination rates are low.

As a reminder, at Dunwoody the vaccination rate on our campus is as follows: Residential Living – 99.7% Personal Care – 100% Long Term Residents- 97% Staff – 74%

We are currently only hiring vaccinated staff and we have shared our intent to move to mandatory COVID-19 vaccination for current staff upon full approval by the FDA. Please continue to wash your hands, social distance and be mindful of places where you may come into close contact with people who are unvaccinated and where you may be more at risk for close contact.
