

General Visitation Guidelines

Failure to abide by the following guidelines will result in visitors being asked to leave the premises.

- 1. For indoor visitation: 2 visitors permitted at a time.
- 2. For outdoor visitation: 4 visitors permitted at a time.
- 3. Visits will be limited to one hour.
- 4. Upon visitors' arrival, each visitor must utilize the hand sanitizer, fill out the visitor screening form and have their temperature checked.
- 5. All visitors are required to wear masks **throughout their visit**, **regardless of vaccination status**. Surgical/procedure masks will be provided. Cloth masks are not permitted.
- 6. Visitors may not sit or lay in residents' beds. Please utilize the chairs in the room. If additional seating is needed, please ask the nursing staff.
- 7. During the visit, visitors must stay in their loved one's room or designated visitation area.
- 8. No eating/drinking during indoor visits. Food and drink are permitted if visiting outdoors.
- 9. Visitors must keep their personal protective equipment (mask) on at all times during the visit, including when in their loved ones' rooms.
- 10. Visitors must maintain social distancing. Physical touching is not recommended.
- 11. Visitors are not to provide hands-on care for their loved ones.
- 12. Visitors must contact nursing staff for any needs.
- 13. Children age 12 and older may visit indoors as long as they are able to follow all safety requirements as outlined for visitors.
- 14. Children under the age of 12 may attend outdoor visitation.
- 15. At the end of the visit, visitors will sign-out at the care center front desk.
