

Dear Residents, Families and Staff,

The big news this week is that the main entrance has moved to Door 1 by the Transportation Office! Our new reception desk is in place near Door 1 and we are finalizing the set up there. The transformation of the former main entrance has begun with a great Dunwoody team completing cleaning, painting and furniture re-location in record time. The bar will be moved to its <u>new</u> home in the corner of the <u>new</u> lounge and boasts a <u>new</u> custom storage closet to house the bar "supplies". This morning residents were already gathered with coffee enjoying the space and each other which is exactly what we envisioned! Please know we will be tweaking the layout of the space over the next few days and weeks. Thanks in advance for your patience as we get it just right!

All visitors and vendors should enter Door 1 and complete our COVID-19 screening and check in with the receptionist. Only Residents may enter Door 2. No visitors or vendors may enter Door 2 at any time. No one should enter the building under the porte cochere; however, residents may exit through the lounge doors under the porte cochere.

On Sunday September 5th, one fully vaccinated dining employee tested positive for COVID-19. That employee is isolating at home and now symptom free. The employee had a few close contacts at Dunwoody but all tested negative. Our current employee vaccination rate is 85.6%. All employees will be fully vaccinated by October 1, 2021 unless they requested and were granted a religious exemption. Please continue to be mindful as you visit with family and friends that our local positivity rate was 6.75% through Sunday September 5th.

Health & Wellness

As always, Dunwoody will have an on-site flu vaccination clinic with Phoebe Pharmacy. We are also continuing to monitor recommendations for the COVID-19 Booster and will make plans accordingly. We will update everyone as soon as possible.

Beginning Friday, September 10th, the Bar will open on Fridays, in addition to Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. On September 14th, the bar will move to the new lounge area (the former main entrance).

Hallway cleanup progress

The team has completed inspections on the first and second floors of the apartment building. Letters have been sent to residents that are not following the policy and re-inspection is scheduled. The team will be working on the 3rd and 4th floors in the next week or so. The hallways are really starting to take shape. We use blue tape to mark everything that will be removed from the hallways. If we marked something that is yours, please let us know. Our plan is once we have everything marked, we will gather all items and allow staff a chance to take things they may want and then we will get rid of the rest. Shredding Event:

On Friday, September 10th the shredder truck will be at Dunwoody from 9:00 a.m. – Noon outside the Main Entrance Lobby. Construction Update:

On the exterior of the building the excavator continues to install rain leaders to convey roof water to the underground basin. The EIFS contractor is beginning to prepare and start the exterior finish on the apartment side of the building.

Inside the addition, ceilings continue to be framed, and some large kitchen equipment has been moved in so that the kitchen walls can be finished. The mechanical contractor is continuing work in the mechanical room and the work continues related to the boilers and heat and the new domestic water.
