## Care Center Update

One staff member who works on our Cedars West personal care unit tested positive for Covid-19 on 10/25/2021. Tracing has been completed to identify anyone at Dunwoody who the staff member had close contact with. All residents on Cedars West have been tested per State guidance and facility policy and all tests came back negative. Residents will be tested a second time 7-10 days after the positive case was identified. Cedars West is currently on "yellow" infection control precautions and therefore, only scheduled compassionate visits are allowed on the unit until restrictions are lifted on November 8, 2021.

## **Accushield**

On Tuesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, we will be switching our check-in system for staff, vendors and employees. The system is pretty easy to use and once you have signed in once, it is pretty quick. It also has a mobile app that can be downloaded onto your phone. To download the Mobile app – please go to the app store on your phone and type Accushield mobile. Download the App onto your phone. The questions can be filled out an hour before your shift. You will be able to answer the questions on the phone, scan a code, take your temperature and that is it! Staff will be on site for all shifts to help people sign in. Please be patient as we switch to this on-line system.

## **Construction Update**

On the outside of the new building, the EIFS continues, and is close to being finished. The stone mason will start in the next several days and put the stone veneer onto the building. We are awaiting final confirmation of the flat roof material delivery, but it is due in next week! Our date was pushed one week to 11/3/21. Cross your fingers!

Inside the building, telephone and data rough-ins are ongoing, lights are being installed, and the new generator is slowly being tied into more of the existing buildings systems. Once the roof starts and sections of the building become fully watertight, insulation and drywall will start in those areas.
