### **Covid-19 Update**

Fortunately, Delaware County's Covid-19 positivity rate has decreased from 24.8% to 16.6% week-over-week, 1/25/22-2/1/22, and area hospitals are reporting a significant decrease in the number of cases presenting. However, Delaware County continues to be an area of "high-risk" Covid-19 transmission, and we ask that all residents and staff remain cautious. Residential residents should notify Health & Wellness immediately if exposed to someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 or is symptomatic.

Skilled Nursing, Personal Care, and Residential Living currently have no positive Covid-19 resident cases. We continue to have a few positive cases amongst our staff; the number of employee cases being identified has also decreased notably.

#### Visitation

Please follow information as posted on our website for visitation guidelines for the Care Center. Dunwoody Village strongly discourages unvaccinated individuals to visit due to increased risk to themselves and our residents. All visitors to Residential Living are required to check in with Accushield before proceeding to any of the residential residences.

#### Construction

The main focus in the building is getting ceilings completed. Lights, sprinkler heads, HVAC grilles, fire alarm and smoke detectors, and wireless internet access points all need to be installed and connected to the infrastructure that was put in during the rough-in phase. Trim, cabinets and flooring are ongoing. Ceramic tile is well underway, and the epoxy flooring that will be installed in the kitchens will start next week.
