Father's Day Dining Option for Care Center Residents

Dining Services will be providing a special noon meal and boutonniere for Care Center residents who choose to dine in their rooms, but you may opt to have the noon meal at Brunch in Hearthside on Father's Day. If choosing to dine in Hearthside, notify your nurse who will contact dietary to remove the noon meal ticket for tray delivery to your room. Please notify your nurse as early as Friday but no later than Sunday, June 19th by 9:00 a.m. Guests are limited to 2 per room and subject to restrictions listed below:

Father's Day Brunch

On Sunday, June 19, 2022, Brunch will be served in Hearthside Dining from **12:00 – 1:30 p.m.** While outside guests are not permitted to dine-in on a regular basis, in honor of Father's Day, residents are permitted to have family members dine with them for Brunch in the Hearthside on June 19th with the following restrictions:

- Residents (Independent, Skilled or Personal Care) can have 2 visiting guests per household or room.
- Guests are required to check-in with Accushield and are required to wear masks unless eating and drinking while seated at the table.
- The cost is \$21.00 per guest.
- Cash is not accepted.
- Credit or debit cards may be used or the cost can be charged to the resident's account.
- Reservations are not required.
- To-Go will be available from 12:00 1:30 p.m.

COVID-19 Update

As of 6/16/22 we have 2 IL residents tested positive who are on strict quarantine and 4 residents are on modified quarantine due to exposure. One Care Center resident tested positive and is on quarantine. Four employees tested positive and are isolating at home.

The Host can access the information quickly from either a Tablet or the Terminal in Hearthside and inform you what your remaining meal balance is for the current month. There will also be a Resident Portal coming where you will have access via Touchtown to log into your Fullcount resident account at your leisure and see both balances and activity.

Construction

Phase I furniture is scheduled to arrive Tuesday June 21 thru Thursday June 23rd. Furniture to be delivered includes the administrative, dining and accounting offices, administrative conference room furniture, dining tables, chairs and banquette seating, auditorium chairs, history studio table and chairs, arts and crafts chairs and fitness studio chairs. Administration is temporarily housed in Apartment A302 and will soon move to Apartment G205 (where Human Resources was housed). Human Resources will be moving into the 3 new offices behind the Auditorium and Accounting/Billing will be moving into the lower offices near West Country Connector Hall and the Fitness Studio.

Due to final Hearthside furniture delivery, there will be no resident or employee lunch served on Wednesday, June 22nd and Thursday, June 23rd. Residents already on the lunch plan can pick up Chef Selection of a cold box lunch in the area outside of Marketing. A dining staff member will be present at the pick-up table. Dinner will be served in Hearthside during regular dinner hours 5:00 – 6:30 pm every day throughout the upcoming week, including Wednesday, June 22nd and Thursday, June 23rd. Coffee and Continental Breakfast will be served outside of Marketing starting on Monday, June 20th through Friday, June 24th.

Demolition is mostly complete, with some miscellaneous items still remaining. Due to unforeseen conditions, old insulation is being removed from the auditorium and lobby roof areas and will be replaced with thicker insulation that meets current energy codes. The installation process will likely start next week. As a result, no other work can take place in this space; however, work will continue on the roof and lower level. Underground plumbing for the stormwater and sanitary sewer system are ongoing on the lower level. The round skylight at the main entrance has been removed, and its replacement will be installed over the next few days. Once the skylight installation is complete, the old roof over this phase will start to be removed and replaced.
