HVAC Addition to WCH Hallway

As part of the dinning expansion project, the West Country House Hallway will receive an addition to the hallway HVAC unit called a DOAS (dedicated outdoor air system). This system will be placed outside along the building by door 15 behind the carport. In addition to the unit being placed outside and ductwork running into the building, there will be 2 exhaust fans placed in the ceiling of the hallway to help circulate conditioned air. This work will start next week with installing a concrete pad outside the building for the unit to sit, followed by the installation of the ductwork and exhaust fans in the ceiling.

DOAS is an HVAC system specifically designed to precondition the outside air brought into a building. A DOAS system can be installed as an addition to your existing HVAC equipment; however, it is more commonly designed as part of an overall HVAC strategy for a new building or space. It has many benefits, including cost savings, increased occupant comfort, and reduced energy consumption.

Resident Directory/Touchtown

Residents will receive an updated directory in their mailboxes by Friday, May 27. For the residents on Touchtown – the application on your device includes a resident directory right at your fingertips Therefore, we do not need to print a directory as often as we normally do. Following this version, Kayla will provide an updated paper directory twice a year. When it is complete, copies will be provided at the front desk for those who want it. If you have not attended a training session for Touchtown yet – Kayla will be holding open sessions every Friday at 3:00 pm in the auditorium.

Employee meals going "cashless" beginning Wednesday 06/01/2022

- *Employees* are reminded that Dunwoody Village is adopting a "cashless" meal purchasing program beginning Wednesday 06/01/2022. Employees will be able to use the following cashless options to purchase meals:
- Pay for meals via payroll deduction or with credit and debit cards.
 - "Payroll Deduction Authorization Forms" were provided two weeks ago but can still be completed and returned to Human Resources. Forms can be picked up at either reception desk, outside of the HR office, or from your department director. You will not be able to use payroll deduction until you have completed a form.
 - Employees will also be able to use a personal credit card, a personal debit card, or our brandnew Dunwoody Village gift cards. These cards can be purchased in any amount. Simply speak with a member of the Dining Services management team or the cashier to purchase a gift card.
 - Gift cards must also be purchased by credit or debit card. Cashiers cannot accept cash.
- Employees should also be aware that as our construction project winds down later in the summer a
 designated employee dining space will be provided. After Phase 2 completion, there will be a new,
 separate break room for our employees dining needs, equipped with seating and a beverage station.
