Dear Residents, Families, and Staff,

There is a lot of activity on campus and we appreciate your cooperation in staying clear of the construction areas and thank you for your patience with the change in walkways. Hope you can begin to enjoy outdoor activities with the warmer weather we are experiencing!

COVID Update

Currently one resident and five staff members in the Care Center have tested positive for COVID-19 and are under quarantine. As of today (05/20/2022), there are 2 Residential Living residents who are under quarantine. Several residents are under modified quarantine due to exposure.

Masks in Common Areas

Due to the increasing positivity rate of COVID-19 in Delaware County and on the Dunwoody campus, residents should continue to wear masks in all common areas unless eating or drinking while sitting at a table. We will again reevaluate the situation again next week. Thank you for your cooperation!

Change in Walkways

Beginning yesterday (Thursday 05/19/2022) the hallway is closed from the Hearthside dining room to the Memorial Garden hallway doors. It will reopen by dinner time on Tuesday 05/31/2022.

- **From the Care Center and East Country Houses:**

If on the upper level, you may use Memorial Garden doors to outside, walk outside to the main entrance lobby to reenter the building, OR use the Terrace (Woodlea) elevator (push elevator button **W**). Use the lower level and proceed to the stairwell in Furniture Hall or continue through Furniture Hall to Elevator 7 to the 2nd floor. Once you are on the 2nd floor from either the outside entrance or the elevator – proceed down the J hallway and continue to Dining.

- **From the Village and West Country Houses:**

In order to reach Health & Wellness, the Pool, or other lower-level areas, WCH residents should use the lower-level route currently in place from WCH Hallway. Village residents should use Elevator 7 or the stairwell outside of the old Gift Shop and follow the established lower-level route currently in place. You may reach dining by passing through the 2nd floor J Hallway and continue into Dining.

- Coffee and continental breakfast continue to be available in Hearthside
- Soups are low-sodium and no sodium.
- **Hours of operation:**
 - **Lunch: Monday – Friday - 11:30 AM - 1:30 PM**
 - **Dinner: Monday – Saturday - 5:00 PM - 6:30 PM**
 - **Sunday: 12:00 PM – 1:30 PM**
- Please consider staggering arrival times between 5 PM and 6 PM to avoid long lines. Thank you!
- Heated plates are available upon request.
- A microwave oven has been placed outside of the 1712 venue and is now available for use.
- In addition to the menus placed on the Lounge table, a menu will be posted near the resident bulletin board outside of Marketing. Menus will be posted by 12:00 PM each day.

May Dining:

- **As of May 23 the 1712 venue will become the location of the temporary bar.**
- **Starting May 26 gala apples, green peppers, and strawberries will be organic.**
- Residents have selected 1 of 2 choices:
 - Residents on the meal plan for May **received a card to be used for up to 45 meals**. Those meals are non-transferrable and Options will not be given. Valid (non-expired) Options may be used in combination with this plan through May 31.
 - Residents off the meal plan for the month may use valid (non-expired) Options for lunches and dinners.
 - Please be reminded that all valid options must be used by May 31.
- Meals - including dine-in and take-out - continue to be available in Hearthside (Casual Dining) for lunch and dinner.
- Residents may order their meals at the Hearthside counter and select a seat. Upon request, wait staff will bring the meals to the table.
- Beverages are table side for all dining in.
- Guests are not permitted for “dine-in” service during May. We will keep you updated concerning guests.
