The J-Hall renovations are near completion and we are awaiting township inspection for the final certificate of occupancy. Furniture installation has been moved up 1 week and will begin on Monday, March 10<sup>th</sup>. Furniture and finish installation is expected to take 1 week. With the luck of the Irish, we anticipate that the staff will move into Marketing and Administration the week of March 17<sup>th</sup>. ### COMMUNITY CENTER ELEVATOR

Elevator 9 replacement parts are ordered with the work expected to take place in the month of April. This was an unforeseen mechanical malfunction of the hydraulic system requiring custom made replacement parts to properly address this issue.

## LOWER-LEVEL CORRIDOR RENOVATION

The lower-level corridor renovation project is complete with the exception of new flooring installation. This product is expected to be delivered toward the beginning of April with installation to follow soon after it arrives. The added furniture and artwork for The Hub is anticipated to be delivered toward the middle or end of March. Once finishes are complete, we will be working with various committees of residents and employees to plan out the final touches and furniture/artwork for the remainder of the corridor.

### WIFI PROJECT

All material (switches, WAPs [wireless access points], etc.) have been obtained and our vendor is making a final inventory. We will be meeting in the near future to discuss the installation and schedule of the new system and to plan out phases of the project. This schedule will be distributed as soon as we have more information. Additionally, we are working with our contracted IT (Information Technology) company to develop a solution to not only increase our campus internet bandwidth substantially but to also install a redundant system to reduce internet outages.

### DEER POPULATION

The township has concluded their planned deer population count and data gathering. They will be working on the next steps to address the deer population in the township and area. We are awaiting the details of their plan to determine our next course of action.

# INFECTION CONTROL

One Residential and 3 Care Center residents are respiratory illnesses and are on quarantine. No staff members are reported to have respiratory illnesses at this time.
