WIFI

The WIFI installation successfully started this week in the J-Building and Administration. We also replaced some common area devices that were low impact to accelerate the Wireless Access Point switch out. So far, approximately 40 Wireless Access Points (WAPs) have been replaced. We will continue to replace devices on Monday, April 28th starting on the Second Floor of Section A and working through the whole second floor before moving on to another location. The WAP replacement in your unit should only take about 20 minutes and technicians or Dunwoody staff can help get your devices reconnected to the new network. The replacement of the switches will be coordinated towards the end of the project.

Elevator 9

The work in elevator 9 started this week and we are making steady progress. We anticipate another 2 to 3 weeks of work for the complete installation. Our vendor is also working to coordinate the final testing and inspection for us to put the elevator back online.

Lower-Level flooring

The Lower-Level flooring installation is underway and making good progress. This work will continue through the first half of next week with the baseboards to complete the project. Remember to avoid this area during non-business hours to allow the installation of the new product.

Generator and Power Outages/Testing

On Tuesday, April 22nd, the temporary generator and transfer switch were successfully tied into the campus's electrical system and tested. This resulted in the planned outages you experienced. The connection and testing went very smooth and resulted in less downtime than anticipated. Thank you for your patience during this inconvenience.
