## Wi-Fi

Over the past week, we have identified and resolved the issue with a network switch that directly impacted 24 Wi-Fi Access Points and the Wi-Fi connection in various areas of our community. The Wi-Fi connection was interrupted for a six-day period in areas near or surrounding the Finance office, Human Resources office, Administration, the main lobby, and the Hearthside dining area. The Wi-Fi connection in these areas is now operational.

Our current Wi-Fi equipment and connection is managed by Single Digits. The current Wi-Fi project includes Dunwoody purchasing the network equipment and transferring the management of the Wi-Fi connection to Meriplex. Many of the interruptions result from the replacement of the old equipment and testing of the new equipment. Meriplex will provide additional support to directly address and assist with any Wi-Fi escalations that may arise. As we work towards the final transfer of the management of the Wi-Fi network from Single Digits to Meriplex in late August, there will continue to be minor interruptions. We understand your frustrations and apologize for any inconveniences these interruptions may cause.
