## **Scams**

Please be on alert for additional scams. New scams include emails or telephone calls from scammers reporting to be from technology companies like Google indicating your account has been hacked but that they will help you to reset the password. They will send a separate password reset email asking you to enter your login credentials, and you will be asked to provide a code that was also sent. This is to provide time for the scammers to hijack your account. Also be aware of fake refund emails from scammers posing to be from Amazon. These emails indicate your most recent purchase failed a quality check and you are due a refund. **Do not press the link!** It is a scam. As always, we recommend that you never push a link the first time you read an email. Take a deep breath and walk away from the computer and call a family member or a friend. This will likely help you to realize you were almost scammed. Do not even be tempted to press the link to a party invitation. Be sure you know who is sending the invitation and check with the person to be sure they sent it. You can respond after you have confirmed there really is a party! Remember big tech companies are not calling you to tell you they want you to reset a password. Big tech companies do not have time to engage us! Do not engage with scammers on the phone or via email or text. Simply delete the information or hang up the phone. When you engage, your information is often shared on the dark web and you will likely become a target again.
