Dear Residents, Families and Staff:

On Tuesday, September 16th, there will be a power shutdown affecting the Dunwoody Village campus to restore the original generator back to service. The full campus outage will occur at 5:00 a.m. and last for approximately one hour or less. Emergency generators will be running, but the Village Apartments, Country Homes and Penrose will be in the dark during that period of time. Please prepare for the brief outage by making sure that your cell phone and other devices are charged throughout the night. Make sure to have a flashlight ready for use (cell phones also have a flashlight) should you need to move about your home during the time of the outage. If you need to be up a certain time to get ready for your flu shot, please set the alarm on your cell phone.
