NOTICE: Hallway Furnishings

In Dunwoody's commitment to be compliant with our recently published Hallway Furnishings Policy for the Village, we will begin the process of removal of certain Dunwoody furnishings.

If you have placed your furniture in the common area for loan, please place your name on the bottom of the furniture for identification or inform Administration, and we will let you if it needs to be removed. If the furniture is not identified, we have no way of determining ownership. If the furniture is broken, damaged or considered a safety hazard, Dunwoody reserves the right to immediately remove the furniture. We will be identifying Dunwoody hallway furnishing items on the list for removal and will do our best to post notice in the memo as needed. If you believe any furnishing identified belongs to you or another resident, please inform Administration.

- The large cabinet outside of A-308 is identified for removal. If you have books or puzzles stored in the cabinet, please plan to remove them by June 1, 2026.
- 3rd Floor – end of hallway in the area of Elevator 3 --tall, narrow cabinet between fire extinguisher and window will be removed.

Power Washing

Power washing will start in **West Country Houses** this Tuesday. The schedule is dependent on the weather. All power washing will be done from the outside and will not require interior access to apartments/units. To prepare, we ask that residents remove small plants, decorative items and personal belongings including rugs. The vendor will move tables and chairs aside as space on the balconies allow. Heavy or larger items will be worked around but will not be moved. After West Country Houses, the team will be moving to East Country Houses and finally to Penrose.

Brunch Details: Upon arrival, residents and guests will check in with the host at the stand located near scooter parking and will be escorted to their table.
